Novice Dog/Novice Handler.

Dogs and handlers that have NOT placed in any test or trial inc. COM.

Novice.

Dogs which have NOT won a Novice Test, or gained a 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open Test or ANY Field Trial award, incl. COM.

Puppy.

Confined to dogs NOT older than 18 months on the day of Test.

Open.

Open to ANY Dog, with or without awards.
